



Project Graduation: Power Hour Series

Each session in this series will focus on a 60 minute “Power Hour” session on different aspects of preparing students for graduation. Topics will include a deep dive into Ohio’s new Graduation Requirements, updates to the Ohio Means Jobs website and resources, Successbound strategies for Building Community Partnerships and a Business Advisory Council, Transition Plans/Transition Planning, and using the Career Connections Framework with Efficacy and Efficiency in order to best ensure Student Enrollment, Enlistment, Employment, and/or Engagement in the Community. Following each “Power Hour” will be an optional 30 minute Q&A and peer-to-peer networking session for participants to share ideas and dive deeper into the content and implementation strategies discussed during the 60 minute presentation.
