



New Special Education Administrator Network – Year 1

This multi-session, two year cohort training is designed specifically for new or recently assigned special education administrators, or those responsible for special education administration with a building or district as a district representative. Year one will focus on building foundational knowledge while year two will support using knowledge to impact overall school improvement.

Participants will: dive into the foundation of special education – federal and state requirements, using the lens of IDEA to guide understanding of district and school-wide policies, procedures and practices; will gain foundational knowledge of the law, which can contribute to the disposition and skills necessary to build special education instructional leaders, leading to improved outcomes for students with disabilities; and will have the opportunity to reflect and evaluate current district policies, practices and processes specific to special education.
